

Cricket skills assessment criteria

The criteria will assess aptitude across the areas listed below. Applicants will be scored under a RAG rating (Red, Amber, Green) with up to 3 points for each element within each of the areas. The highest possible score is 198 (a score of 9 across all elements). The minimum score to demonstrate aptitude is 110.

Batting	
1	Showcase the ability to play effectively on the front and back foot
2	Shows ability to create scoring opportunities against pace and spin
3	Shows a solid foundation in set up and defence against pace and spin
4	Shows balance and adaptability in moving around the crease to score to all areas
Fielding	
1	Confidence and movement towards the ball
2	Shows the ability to catch a variety of catches
3	Attack and release the ball quickly
4	Accuracy in throwing a variety of distances
5	Communication skills and energy during fielding
Seam	
1	Showcases the ability to bowl length at pace to challenge the top of the stumps
2	Show ability to bowl variations – Yorker / Swing / Slower balls
3	Challenge the batter to create wicket taking opportunities
4	Shows a repeatable run up, action and following to generate spin
Spin	
1	Showcases the ability to maximise spin on the ball
2	Challenge the batter to create wicket taking opportunities
3	Shows ability to bowl variations in spin
4	Shows ability to create a consistent flight in the ball
5	Shows a repeatable run up, action, and following to generate spin
Wicket keeping	
1	Showcases a solid wicket keeping posture
2	Shows the ability to catch a variety of catches
3	Shows agility and lateral movement
4	Communication skills and energy during fielding
