From Monday 30 January 2022, students in Year 7 and Year 9 will complete assessments in all subjects. The assessment period will last for two weeks and will end on Friday 10 February. Teachers will communicate with their students when the assessment for their subject is due to take place within this window. Each assessment is carefully designed to allow students to demonstrate their knowledge, understanding and application of previously learnt material.

Following the collection and analysis of results from this round of assessments, you will receive a report showing both the attainment and progress your child has made. The progress report will indicate the relative progress your child has made from KS2, and the attainment will indicate the standard achieved relative to their year group.

The look, cover, write, check work your child completes for homework each evening, along with other revision strategies (as discussed with your child throughout the course of their studies) will be crucial to their success in these assessments.
