New procedure for Extra Curricular Club – important please read

We have recently reviewed the systems and procedures for extra curricular clubs in primary. This will improve communication and fairness regarding clubs.

The main change is that instead of signing up for a club at the beginning of the year, we will now arrange sign up on a term by term basis. You can register your interest through an online form (see below) and we will confirm in writing on the first week of each term what club your child can attend. All previous communication should be ignored. You need to follow the new procedure to sign up for clubs.

How do I sign up?

Please click on <https://forms.office.com/e/WcL3V00Haz> to request a place at the extra curricular clubs. We will contact you via email by **Friday 13 January** to confirm which clubs your child is in. Please speak to the school office if you have not received an email confirmation by then.

Please ignore any previous communication regarding clubs. Anybody wanting to attend a club in term 3 should follow this link.

We advise that students attend 1 club over the course of the year. If your child would like to attend more than one we can accommodate that, if we have spaces available. I need later childcare, what can I do?

If your child attends the paid after school club provision with PE Partner, they can still attend the extra-curricular clubs and will then be dropped off at after school club. **You will still be required to pay PE Partners for that club until 4:50pm.**

PE Partners offer high quality after school sports activities lead by a qualified coach at DTC. PE Partner clubs run every afternoon school is open over the school year. The often run in the holidays too at other local venues. PE Partner club is charged at £4 per hour from 3:50 -4:50pm Monday – Thursday or £7 for Fridays 2 – 4pm. What happens if I am late to pick up?

Please collect your child at 4:30pm from the side primary gate. We understand accidents happen, however our staff time is extremely important to us, especially when they are volunteering extra time to run a club. Therefore, if you are late to pick up on more than one occasion, your child’s place at the club will be revoked.

Please remember extra curricular clubs are not to be used as childcare, but aimed at students trying new experiences, having an opportunity to follow their passions and hobbies and learning and developing skills outside of the curriculum.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank the staff for giving up their time to provide these extra-curricular clubs for the students at Dixons Trinity Chapeltown so that they access and enjoy a range of activities outside of the school day.
