Dear families

As you may be aware, the government made new announcements on 2 January regarding Covid 19 and provided new guidance for schools in England. As with most places of work, we have very limited staffing across the Academy. We need to respond to this to ensure that we are providing a quality education for all our students. This will mean some disruption to normal learning, but we have tried very carefully to minimise the impact of this.

Consequently, considering our current staff absence, we have taken the decision to direct our Year 4 students to learn from home on Tuesday 25 January and Wednesday 26 January; this may be extended depending on staffing.

Students should access their work via a link on the school website, which they can find on the academy home page. If your child has limited or no access to the internet, all students have been provided with a work booklet. Students must complete a written quiz for each of their subjects, which will be checked on their return to school. If your child has any issue accessing the work, please contact the academy.

All other year groups are expected to attend school as normal. Our attendance procedures and policies remain the same for all other year groups.

We will be in touch on Wednesday afternoon with an update and will also provide updates on the academy website as we continue to respond to our staffing situation.
