Dear families

As you may be aware, the government made new announcements on 2 January regarding Covid 19 and provided new guidance for schools in England. As with many places of work, we have very limited staffing across the Academy. We need to respond to this to ensure that we are providing a quality education for all our students. This will mean some disruption to normal learning, but we have tried very carefully to minimise the impact of this.

Consequently, considering our current staff absence, we have taken the decision to direct our EYFS students to learn from home on Monday 31 January and Tuesday 1 February 2022; this may be extended, depending on staffing.

All other year groups are expected to attend school as normal. Our attendance procedures and policies remain the same for all other year groups.

As always, we will keep you up to date with any changes we have to make. Our aim is always to have our students in the building, but we also must ensure this is done safely with the appropriate number of staff.
