Important please read: new procedure for Extra Curricular Club

We have recently reviewed the systems and procedures for extracurricular clubs in primary and have identified a need to reassess the process to improve communication and fairness. Instead of signing up for a club at the beginning of the year, we will now arrange sign up on a term-by-term basis. You can register your interest using the online form sent via text during the first week of each term, we will confirm in writing which club your child can attend. **All previous communication must now be ignored, and the new sign-up procedure must be followed.**

How do I sign up?

We will ensure that place allocation is fair, and students can attend at least one club over the course of the year. If your child would like to attend more clubs, we can accommodate that, if there are spaces available. I need later childcare, what can I do?

If your child attends the paid after school club provision with PE Partner, they can still attend the extra-curricular clubs and will then be dropped off at the after-school club. **You will still be required to pay PE Partners for that club until 4:50pm.**

PE Partners offer high quality after school sports activities lead by a qualified coach. Their clubs run every afternoon that school is open throughout the school year. The often run in the holidays too at other local venues. PE Partner club is charged at £4 per hour from 3:50 -4:50pm Monday – Thursday or £7 for Fridays 2 – 4pm.
